WHAT YOU SHOULDN'T POST AT ALL:

Posts containing the following content will be removed, and users will have their accounts immediately suspended and/or deleted.

Racist, misogynistic, transphobic, homophobic, ableist slurs, or other derogatory pejoratives for oppressed identity groups (unless you belong to that group and are reclaiming the term)

Blatantly racist, casteist, ableist, sexist, transphobic, or otherwise chauvinistic and bigoted discourse

Symbols and slogans associated with fascist regimes and/or fascist, third-positionist, western chauvinist or white nationalist movements

Arguments that seek to deny or cast doubt on historic or ongoing acts of genocide

Pedophilia/MAP content, in all its manifestations

Purposeful misinformation
